PRAY

- What are you thankful for today?
- What cares, concerns, or challenges are going on?
- What do you need for things to be better?

PEOPLE

- Read the Bible passage out loud
- Retell the passage in your own words as if you were telling a friend.
- What do we learn about God?
- What does this say about people?

PURPOSE

- According to this study, what am I doing well?
- What do I need to change? "I will grow by..."
- Who needs to hear this story, and how can I tell them?

Blessed are those who hear the Word and obey it.
