Who We Are

Park Avenue Church of Christ is a warm, growing congregation of approximately 400-500 in Denison, Texas — rooted in decades of faithful ministry and positioned for a new season of growth. We are a church that takes both the gospel and our community seriously.

We trace our history to the Armstrong Avenue Church of Christ, where generations of Denison families were baptized, married, and buried. In 1987 we made a faith-filled move to our current Park Avenue location, and we have been investing in that decision ever since.

Our Leadership Structure

Park Avenue is elder-led, with 7 elders who give prayerful oversight to the congregation's direction and spiritual health. Day-to-day ministry is carried out by a team of 5 ministers and supported by 2 administrative assistants. Fourteen deacons serve faithfully across the congregation's practical needs.

This is a congregation with real leadership depth — people who have been here through hard seasons and good ones, and who are committed to where this church is going.

Our Worship Life

Sunday morning worship is the heartbeat of Park Avenue. We value worship that is reverent and accessible, rooted in Scripture, and led with excellence — not performance. Our tradition is a cappella, and the congregation sings with genuine conviction.

Around 2000 we transitioned Sunday evenings from traditional worship services to home-based Discipleship Ministry Communities (DMCs). This means Sunday morning carries even greater weight as the gathered, corporate experience of the whole church family. The worship minister shapes that experience every week.

Ministry Breadth

With over 25 active ministries, Park Avenue is a full-ministry congregation. A worship minister here will work alongside a rich ecosystem of ministry — not in isolation. Key areas include:

- Discipleship Ministry Communities (DMCs) — home-based small groups meeting weekly
- Children, youth, and family ministries with dedicated staff
- Missions and global outreach, including Casa de la Esperanza
- The Barnabas Center — community benevolence ministry
- Senior adult, men's, and women's ministries

Our Moment

The Texoma region is in the midst of one of the most significant economic expansions in North Texas history. Texas Instruments and GlobiTech are investing over \$35 billion in semiconductor manufacturing in nearby Sherman — expected to bring thousands of new families to Grayson County in the next decade.

In 2026, Park Avenue launched its third capital campaign to expand and modernize its worship facilities in preparation for this growth. Vision 2035 is our goal: a thriving congregation of 700, equipped to reach the people who are coming.

What We're Looking For

We are seeking a worship minister who leads from a place of genuine faith, not just musical skill — someone who understands that Sunday morning is discipleship, not performance. We want a leader who can shepherd the congregation through song, connect worship to the sermon and the Word, and help our people sing like they mean it.

Experience with a cappella worship leadership is essential. A heart for collaboration — with the preaching minister, the elders, and the broader ministry team — is equally important. This is a church that is preparing for growth, and the worship experience will be one of the first things new families encounter.
